**Results are collected from the ECO area between 8:00am and 10:30am.** Throughout both mornings members of staff will be available to offer advice and guidance where necessary.

We understand that some students may not be able to collect their results in person. To accommodate this, results can be collected on a student's behalf by a nominated family member or representative. If you wish for someone else to collect your results, you must email the Examinations Manager, Mrs. J Manning, at [exams@plymstockschool.org.uk](mailto:exams@plymstockschool.org.uk), giving permission and clearly naming the person who will collect them.

The person collecting your results will need to bring:

- A signed letter from you authorising them to collect your results
- Valid photo identification

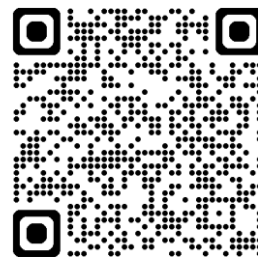
Alternatively, results can be sent to your school email account upon request. Please note that results cannot be given out over the phone.
