Dear Parent/Carer,

RE: YEAR 9 PARENTS' EVENING 12.03.26

I hope you are well. I am writing to inform you about our upcoming **virtual** Year 9 Parents' Evening, which will take place on **Thursday 12 March**.

This Parents' Evening is designed to give you the opportunity to discuss your child's progress in individual subjects, gain a clearer understanding of their strengths and areas for development, and ask any questions you may have. Importantly, these conversations will help inform discussions ahead of the **Year 9 Curriculum Choices Evening on Thursday 19 March**, when students will begin making decisions about their GCSE option subjects.

By attending Parents' Evening, you will be well placed to understand how your child is currently performing across the curriculum and to discuss with subject teachers how this may relate to future choices and pathways.

You may notice that appointments are not available for every subject. This is because some teachers teach across more than one subject area and availability is therefore focused on core teaching commitments; this is most likely to apply to Religious Studies. There will be a full opportunity to explore GCSE options for Religious Studies, along with all other subjects, at our forthcoming Curriculum Choices Evening.

Appointments will be available from 3:45pm to 6:15pm and are made on a first come, first served basis, so the sooner you log onto the system, the more choice you will have. If you encounter any problems or need assistance in making appointments, please contact us on 01752 402679.

Bookings are open from 7pm on Thursday 12 February and will close on Wednesday 11 March just before midnight. After this time, you will not be able to make any further appointments.
